Initiated Constitutional Measure No. 4

This initiated measure would amend sections 1, 14, 15, and 16 and repeal sections 4, 5, 7, 9 and 10 of article X of the North Dakota Constitution. It would

prohibit political subdivisions from levying any tax on the assessed value of real or

personal property, except for the payment

of bonded indebtedness incurred through a certain date, and would require the state to

provide replacement payments to political

subdivisions of no less than the current real property tax levies. It would limit the debt of a political subdivision to an amount not to

exceed two and one-half percent of the full and true value of the real property in the

political subdivision; however, by a vote, an incorporated city could increase its




