1. Call to Order  
 Board President Kortney Kindsfater called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

2. Pledge of Allegiance  
 3. Approval of Agenda Amendments:

Add under New Business: Discussion on maturing Certificate of Deposit (CD).

Add under Miscellaneous Business: Updates on transportation, co-op committee, and finance committee reports.

Motion: Jahner moved to approve the agenda as amended; Clausen seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

4. Approval of Minutes  
 Minutes from the Special School Board Meeting held on October 31, 2024, at 12:00 PM were presented for approval.

Motion: Kilzer moved to approve the minutes as presented; Clausen seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

5. Financial Reports  
 Financial reports covering May 2024 through October 2024 were not reviewed due to pending information.

Motion: Clausen moved to postpone discussion of the financial reports; Kilzer seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

6. Miscellaneous Business

**A. Superintendent/Secondary Principal's Report:**  
**Facilities Updates:**  
 Cement work outside the building is complete.  
 Electrical installation is delayed while awaiting poles.  
 Westin Ginther will handle fencing on the deck.  
**Plumbing:**  
 Heath inspected plumbing and retrieved the building blueprints. Videos of plumbing systems have been requested for documentation.  
**Insurance and Maintenance:**  
 Travelers Insurance inspected the facilities and identified issues. They contacted Burn Boiler for further actions.  
 Brownouts in Hettinger are causing issues with City Air, impacting pool thermostats. Replacement controllers are outdated and limited. Exploring refurbishment options for sustainability.  
**Future Planning:**  
 Curriculum committee need to get together for planning for the business class program for the 2025-2026 school year.  
 Obtaining quotes for new lighting for the football field.  
 Junior High/High School locker replacement estimated at \$125,000.

**B. Elementary Principal's Report:**  
**Events and Initiatives:**  
 The K-6 Christmas concert is scheduled for December 11th 2024 at 1:30 PM.  
 Wellness Committee is organizing a health fair in April, modeled after a wax museum, featuring discounted screenings by the local hospital they are working with WRHS for the event.

**School Meals:**  
 Thanksgiving lunch served roughly 320 meals.

Community members are wanting to start looking into working with local ranchers to integrate local beef into the lunch program.

**Kitchen Needs:**  
 Updates needed for kitchen ventilation systems, including hoods.

Utilizing the Fruit and Veggie Grant to enhance school meals.

**Lunch Balances:**  
 Lunch balance letters sent to families to address outstanding payments.

**C. Athletic Director's Report:**

**Winter Sports:**  
 Wrestling: 22 boys and 3 girls participating. "Meet the Night Hawks" scheduled for November 21st at 5:30 PM, with officials explaining new rule changes.

**Girls' Basketball:** 18 players have started practices.

**Boys' Basketball:** Practices to start the Monday after Thanksgiving, with 14-15 participants anticipated.

**Junior High Updates:**  
 Boys' and girls' teams performing well, though the girls' team is smaller this year.

**Scheduling:**  
 Homecoming scheduled for the week October 3rd 2025 against Standing Rock.  
 Volleyball District 7 changes include 14 matches and three tournaments. Hettinger will host the District 7 JV Volleyball Tournament next year.

**Recognition:**  
 Laela named Region 7 Senior Athlete of the Year.

**D. Business Manager's Report:**  
**TFFR Contributions:**  
 Identified a \$80,000 shortfall in 2023-2024 contributions. Corrections will begin in January 2025 as TFFR transitions to a new system.

**CD Maturity:**  
 A \$20,000 Certificate of Deposit (CD) at Dakota Western Bank has matured.

**Reporting and Training:**  
 Continuing to refine financial reports for clearer presentation to the board.

**Business Manager** has the opportunity to pursue a voluntary two-year certification program for \$2,600, which includes optional test-outs for certain sections.

**7. New Business**  
**A. Maturing Certificate of Deposit (CD):**  
 Discussion on the \$20,000 CD at Dakota Western Bank.

**Motion:** Jahner moved to roll the CD into a new 12-month term and designate Superintendent Darin Seamands, Business Manager Jeremy Fordahl, and Board President Kortney Kindsfater as signatories. Clausen seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

**8. Unfinished Business**  
**A. Transportation:**  
 Need to establish a policy or guidelines defining bus route distances and driver availability. Explore purchasing additional 14-passenger buses to accommodate breakdowns.

**B. Co-op Committee:**  
 Next meeting scheduled for December 18th 2024 to reconcile fall sports.

**C. Finance Committee:**  
 Plan a meeting to review and clarify financial reports with all board members, ensuring understanding of presented data.

Discussed cross-training staff to ensure payroll continuity. Certification training for the Business Manager considered voluntary but beneficial.

**9. Adjournment**  
 Motion: Kilzer moved to adjourn the meeting; Jahner seconded. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:24 PM.
