Recipe: Hawaiian Bread

Ingredients:

Cup warm water (110*F/45*C)

2 (.25ounce) envelopes active dry yeast

1/4 cup white sugar

1 cup pineapple juice

3 eggs

½ cup butter, melted 1 tsp. vanilla extract

½ tsp. ground ginger

½ - 1 tsp. salt

½ cup white sugar 6 cups all-purpose flour

Directions:

In a bowl; put in the warm water, yeast, and the $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of sugar; until it begins to form a creamy foam; about 10 minutes. Beat the yeast mixture with the juice, eggs, butter, vanilla, ginger, salt, and sugar. Stir in 3 cups of flour until no dry spots remain; Stir in the remaining flour; 1/2 cup at a time mixing well to form a stiff dough.

Place dough into a large, lightly-oiled bowl and turn to coat. Cover with a towel and let rise in warm place until doubled in size, about 1 hour.

Deflate the dough and turn it out into a well floured surface Form into balls and let rise until doubled, about 40 minutes. Preheat oven to 350°. Bake buns for 15-20 minutes until golden

Note: you can make mini loaves or different size buns. You can use a round cake pan; lightly grease or put them on a cookie sheet.
