Recipe: **Creamy Turkey Dumpling Soup**

Soup:

3 Tbls. butter

3 carrots, peeled and diced

3 large celery ribs, diced

2 medium potatoes, peeled and diced

1 small onion, peeled and diced

3 cloves garlic, minced

1/4 C. all-purpose flour 10 C. chicken broth

1 C. milk or half and half

4 C. cooked turkey meat, chopped

1 tsp. poultry seasoning (opt)

Dumplings:

2 C. all-purpose flour

2 tsp. baking powder Salt and pepper to taste

1 large egg

Directions:

In a large soup pot, melt the butter over medium heat. Add the carrots, celery, potatoes and onion. Cook until onion is softened. Stir in the garlic and cook for another

Stir in the flour and cook for one minute. Stir in the broth, milk, turkey, salt and pepper and poultry seasoning if you're putting it in. Bring soup to a simmer. For the dumplings - in a medium bowl combine the flour, baking powder, salt and pepper. Stir in the milk and egg just until combined and there isn't any dry flour

Using a small cookie scoop or tablespoon, drop batter on top of the soup. Cover with a tight fitting lid and simmer for 15 minutes; don't peek!!
