ze scored twice and knocked in a run on a single for Shiloh. Berndt, Schneibel, Taytum Risovi (run), Clifdyn Brossart (run), Gavin Bartsch each had one hit for the Panthers.

Bishop Ryan/Nedrose advanced to the consolation championship with an 11-7 win over Renville County. In the championship semi-finals, Thompson edged Northern Cass, 4-3, and LaMoure/Litchville-Marion/Edgeley held off Park River Area, 7-4.
