To everyone reading this, wherever you may be: The people of Forbes cordially invite everyone to join in the celebration of their 140 years as a town. The little community on the South Dakota border is a youngster compared to Ellendale, having organized simultaneously with the extension of the Great Northern Railroad from Ellendale in 1905.

As has long been the tradition, Forbes will host **Dickey County's** best July 4 parade, and it will begin on the south side of town at 10:30. Anyone who would like to join in with a float is encouraged to do so. You may contact Lori Brandenburger or Bobbi Jo Salberg if you need details.

Also as traditional, the great Forbes Fireworks display will begin at dusk. Joan Tviet Hoffman, who for many years has worked with loval volun-

teers to preserve and honor the heritage of the Forbes area, noted several features of the community that the public should know.

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
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
