Sharps Exchange Program: Keep your community safe and always use a SHARPS container. Used sharps are hazardous waste. When not discarded properly they can cut and infect others. Protect your community by always discarding your used sharps in a sharps disposal container. Free sharps containers are available at CliniCare, please see the receptionist or nurse to get your free sharps container and exchange it for a new one when full.

A Medsafe medication disposal bin is now located in CliniCare, Cavalier, ND. Patients can place unwanted prescriptions and OTC medications in this disposal bin, including controlled substances. Liquids less than 4 ml are allowed as long as they are placed in a plastic bag. Items not allowed include illegal drugs, sharps items, aerosol inhalers and liquid chemotherapy agents.
