A regular meeting of the Carrington School District #49 School Board was held on November 12, 2025, at 4:00 PM in the high school library. Present: Angela Kutz and Joel Lemer. Joey Irmen was present via phone. Absent: Tonia Erickson and Dr. Ben Garr. Kimary Edland recorded the minutes. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. By consensus the Board added discussion of state volleyball to the Agenda. It was moved by Kutz, seconded by Irmen and carried (all members voting yes on voice vote) to approve the minutes from October 14, 2025. Dr. Garr via phone at 4:10 PM  
It was moved by Kutz, seconded by Irmen and carried (all members voting yes on voice vote) to approve the check registers and payment of bills.  
Mrs. Helm reported on the all-threat assessment that was done by the North Dakota Safety Council; that David Belgarde reviewed our camera system; that a new bus was delivered on Friday and that another one will be delivered in either December or January; that she and Mrs. Skytland have been busy working on policies and will bring more to the December meeting; presented a facility update; John Porter, director of Southeast Education Cooperative visited our school and shared in the 2024/2025 highlights; shared that she has received many compliments on our volleyball coach, Kadyr Mehning; that she is on the Carrington Community Foundation Board, Common Spirit Health Board, Common Spirit Executive Board for Critical Access Care, Lions, and Kiwanis; that she is currently a leadership mentor for superintendent Chris Triggs, Superintendent Natalie Becker, and Gracie Carr; and that three new copiers will be delivered in December.  
Mr. Weber reported on high school activities including parent-teacher conferences; eighth grade fundraiser; SOS peer mentor training; NHS annual Halloween food drive; FFA Nationals; fall and winter activities, and he presented NDSA test results.  
Mrs. Helseth presented updates from the elementary school including parent teacher conferences, JV One Act Play performance, flag etiquette and Veterans' Day presentation from the Legion Auxiliary; Cardinal Way Awards, Student of the Quarter; American Education Week will include pastries for parents and snacks for teachers; and that her staff has been busy with grade level planning meetings, Coach ELA, IAL learning walks; and that there will be four University of Jamestown practicum students here in November.
