“The times they are a-changin” sang songwriter Bob Dylan back in 1963. Time itself changes sometimes. A little girl and her Grandmother walked into our church in Rolla on a Sunday morning, thinking they were on time, only to realize the service was about to dismiss. They had forgotten to make the daylight saving time adjustment.

Does EVERYTHING change? Let’s look at the Bible for the answer to that question. Malachi 3:6 - “I the LORD do not change.” NIV

James 1:17 – “Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.” NIV

Hebrews 13:8 – “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.” NIV

God remains the same, through the changes of life. He is consistent. We

can count on Him to always keep His promises. He never changes.

His standards do not change either. Sin is still sin. None of the 10 commandments have been dropped from His Law Book, even if some people think they are archaic and neglect them.
