Petition filed to rescind permit for JetX

A coalition of five townships, landowners, and other interested parties have hired a law firm from Minneapolis to litigate the petition to the North Dakota Public Service Commission to rescind the permit it allowed earlier for a JetX power transmission line to be built between Ellendale and Jamestown.

This project was approved by the PSC in November of 2024 on a 2-1 vote. Randy Christman, Public Service Commissioner, wrote in his dissentation that he had not

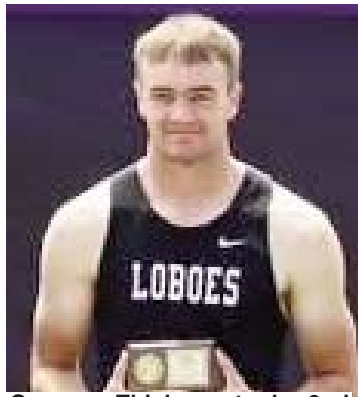

Veterans and volunteers joined together for the latest Honor Flight to the nation's capitol.

This was the 20th local veteran honor flight trip.

The Honor Flight took off Sunday morning, May 4 from Hector International Airport and was gone for two nights.

Of the 101 veterans on the honor flight, 86 served in Vietnam.

Among the Veterans on the flight was Jim Schmoker from LaMoure.

Jim served in Viet Nam in 1971/1972. Jim was crew chief on the medevac helicopter, and also drove a supply truck.
