Join Sheyenne, N.D. as they welcome "Buckin' Brews" on the corner of Main Street (aka. Highway 281) and Richter Avenue which is now open for business.

No drive-thru for this one so park that vehicle, motorcycle or tie up that horse and give those legs a nice stretch in a short walk as you take in some fresh air with hints of the aroma of a cup of coffee from fresh ground beans.

Meet Jocelyn Acheson of Sheyenne, N.D., who has launched her business with a soft grand opening on Saturday, May 31.

"The first week was pretty good with 166 sales, and I already have some regular customers which is exciting," comments Jocelyn. She also quickly credits her sister Josette, who designed the logo for the business and assists when they are open, Monday through Friday, 6 a.m.-2 p.m.

Customers are commenting, too. If you check out her Facebook page she has received these at the serving window: "This is luscious coffee." "I love the location/it's so easy to park here for a quick break and exceptional coffee!"

Jocelyn moved to North Dakota a couple of years ago after her dad passed away, to be with her mom. The family has been renovating the farmstead her mom purchased several years ago, along with getting her new horse trailer converted to a coffee shop.

She is not your average

entrepreneur, having experience in management from previous jobs and, of course, a vision of owning her own business of bringing one of North Dakota's favorite beverages "to" the customer.

The menu features lattes, cold brews and mochas with add-ons like cold foam, whipped cream, oat milk and half and half, and add-ins such as French vanilla, salted caramel, hazelnut and coconut – also including sugar free syrups. She also offers a limited selection of pastries.

Customers can also try the "No Brew, Just Buck" assortments such as Dirty Red Bull and Dirty Sprite which have their own syrups like mango, raspberry, watermelon and more.

At 8:15 A.M. Ashley Lies, State's Attorney gave an update on her department. Lies reported that a recent scheduled jury trial has been cancelled, and rescheduled. Lies has also been working on reviewing and updating the Eddy County Handbook, along with department heads and Commission Chairperson Glenda Collier. Lies also reported that her focus has shifted to working on County issues vs. Court issues as of lately.

At 8:30 A.M. Sheriff Paul Lies gave an update on the Police Department. The Free Fishing Derby has been scheduled for June 8th. Sheriff Lies provided information on the month service calls. The new police body cameras are installed and being used. A new squad car has been ordered. Lies also reported that he is intending to participate in the Task Force Model of the Immigration Nationality Act. Eddy County will be trained to assist with the identification and apprehension of undocumented immigrants who pose a threat to public safety in Eddy County.

OLD BUSINESS:

The tabled discussion on appointing a Zoning Board member to Zoning was discussed. The ad for accepting applications is open until May 23, 2025 and the applications will be reviewed at the next regular Commission meeting.

A credit card for purchasing gas in Sheyenne was discussed. Currently, the gas pumps in Sheyenne only accept major credit cards, and a local charging system is not set up. Farmers Union in Tolna is working on getting a fleet card charging system set up.

Dave Gehrtz made a motion to add Andrew Bachmeier and Timothy Hartl to the Eddy County Credit Card Account with a limit of \$500 each card to be used for gas purchases until a gas card can be obtained through Farmers Union in Tonia. James Allmaras seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

A date was set for the Eddy County Summer Picnic. The picnic will be held at the Eddy Coun-

ty Shop in Sheyenne on July 22. The City of Sheyenne Employees and Council are invited to attend.

Two applications were received and reviewed for the Eddy County Treasurer position. Interview dates and times were discussed. A Special Meeting will be called, as two commissioners will be present to conduct the interviews.

The Commissioners reviewed the Gaming Site Authorization application from the New Rockford Lions Club.

Dave Gehrtz made a motion to approve the Gaming Site Authorization application for the New Rockford Lions Club for gaming at the New Rockford Golf Course. James Allmaras seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.

The Commissioners reviewed the list of PRC Credits for trusts and/or mobile properties that were recently approved by the ND State Legislature. Initially trusts and/or mobile properties did not qualify for the 2024 Primary Residence Credit, but that has since changed and now are qualifying properties.

Dave Gehrtz made a motion to approve the 4 PRC Credits for trusts and/or mobile properties. James Allmaras seconded the motion. All were in favor, motion carried.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Glenda Collier shared that the grant from the Garrison Diversion Recreation Program was awarded to Eddy County in the amount not to exceed \$25,000.00. Eddy County applied for this grant to help fund the construction of the shower houses at the Eddy County Fairgrounds.

With no further business, Glenda Collier adjourned the meeting at 8:53 A.M.

HELP CONTROL NOXIOUS WEEDS

Cost-share assistance available to Eddy County landowners

The Eddy County Weed Board reminds all landowners that state law requires the control of noxious weeds.

4.1-47-02 Control of noxious weeds

- 1) Each person shall do all things necessary and proper to control the spread of noxious weeds
- 2) No person may distribute, sell or offer for sale within this state, a noxious weed

The Eddy County Weed Board is offering a cost share program for chemical for control of noxious weeds on qualifying land. Cost share rates are as follows:

- 80% cost share for Tordon up to 10 gallons
- 50% cost share for 2-4D up to 20 gallons
 - The 2-4D must be tank mixed with Tordon at 2:1 (2 parts 2-4D to 1 part Tordon)
- 80% cost share for Plateau (or the generic version) up to 4 gallons
- 50% cost share for Milestone up to 5 gallons

In order to receive reimbursement, you must submit:

- (1) Invoice or receipt to prove purchase of chemical
- (2) A copy of the maps with sprayed areas highlighted
- (3) The legal description of the land sprayed

They can be mailed to Eddy County Weed Board, 205 3rd St SE, New Rockford, N.D. or dropped off at the Eddy County Extension office or emailed to eddywco@outlook.com. **Requests for reimbursement must be received at the weed board office by JUNE 30, 2025.** If you have questions contact Corey Longnecker at (701) 302-0418.

NOTE: Each invoice submitted must have the requestor's name printed on it. We will NOT accept an invoice with the husband/dad's name on it and then it whited out and the son's/wife/daughters name written over the top or something like that. If you want to take advantage of the full reimbursement limits-plan ahead when you are buying the chemical. Do NOT expect us to try to fix it a few months later.

There will be another round of funding later on for summer and fall spraying but this is special funding we were allotted but MUST be used by **JUNE 30!**
