**Eva Albright**  
Eva Albright, a native of Madison, Miss., is playing the role of Sariah, who Albright described as "a retired beauty queen who is trying to stay the same forever."  
"She is the only character that has an outfit change in the entire show, and I have nine of them," she added. "There's this one scene at the very end where I have maybe a minute to change dresses, and it is always very scary because I can hear how much time I have left."

**Jimmy Rich**  
Jimmy Rich, who hails from a small suburb of Chicago, plays Ham, who he described as "very angry, angry and hurt on the inside."  
Both Albright and Rich heard about DPRCA from past Western Illinois University (WIU) graduates. "Every year, someone talks about it, and it ends up being

on the audition rotation list," said Albright.  
When Rich was asked how he liked New Rockford, he said "It's really nice to be able to experience the small town kind of energy ... when we sang at the street market, it was fun to see this everyone-knows-everyone type of community."

**Tyne Dougherty**  
Tyne Dougherty, from Waco, Texas, is entering her senior year at Belmont University in Nashville. Dougherty is playing the role of Egyptus, who she describes as "an optimus in a very bold, and strong way."  
Later, she said, "I like that this show isn't done very often, so we can build our character to be what we want, and that has been a nice challenge and joy as an actress."

**Micah Cabot**  
Micah Cabot, from Cleveland, Ohio, will start his sophomore year at Elon University in North Carolina in the fall. While portraying Japheth, Cabot noticed "he is kind of the quirky, inventive, nerdy guy of the bunch."
