Approval of the Agenda

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Schumacher to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of the September 8th regular meeting minutes

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Pfeiffer to approve the September 8th, 2025, regular meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of the Consent Agenda

It was moved by Alfstad and seconded by Drake to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously. The consent agenda consisted of the business manager report, and the bills - general fund of \$439,891.06, the building fund of \$24,528.09, the food service fund of \$20,075.15, and the activity fund of \$4,253.31.

Monthly Committee Reports

Board Member Alfstad spoke to the board regarding the building committees meeting. It was shared that the committee will be putting out for bids to finish the interior and electrical for the bus barn. Board Member Schaefer spoke to the board on the transportation committee meeting. The committee met to discuss transportation needs, with a recommendation coming to the board this evening.

Principals' Reports

Secondary Principal Hager was not present at the meeting. Her report was posted for the boards viewing.

Elementary Principal Benz was not present at the meeting. Her report was posted for the boards viewing.

Superintendent Report

Superintendent Becker shared her report with the board. Becker shared with the board the coordination and feedback from the recent Steered Straight assembly. Students and public that attended the event noted it was well received. Discussion with G & R Controls over the service received, and billing issues continue. Work continues updating and

cleaning up Board Policy with the help of the NDSBA. Becker also noted communication, and efforts continue in the areas of technology, grant exploration, bus driver search, and preparation of fire drills. Looking ahead, preparations are underway or complete for parent teacher conference on the 10th, and a required staff training on suicide prevention. In closing Becker noted upcoming meetings, conferences and training she is preparing or attending.

Petition Audit Results

Item was for discussion only as the petition audit conducted by the state audit department is complete. Information was publicly posted previously, so discussion was held on the minimal findings of the audit, and what the terminology means in layman's terms. Discussion was further held on who should conduct the districts next audit, with the item to be brought back for further discussion and decision in November.

14 Passenger Bus Bid Opening

It was moved by Schaefer and seconded by Schumacher to accept the bid from Foreman Sales and Service for the purchase of a new 14 passenger bus as presented. Motion carried with no dissenting votes. The district received one bid in result to the posting for bids. The bid was deemed acceptable in all areas and accepted. Purchase price will be \$99,900.00.

Bus Barn Bid Recommendations

It was moved by Alfstad and seconded by Schaefer to approve the material bid from Cash and Carry Lumber of New Rockford. Motion carried with no dissenting votes. Schumacher abstained from the vote. Two material bids were received. There was only one labor bid received which was deemed not acceptable. The labor side of the project will be re-opened.

It was moved by Alfstad and seconded by Schaefer to approve the Electrical bid from CMC Electric. Motion carried with no dissenting votes. Only one bid was received, but after discus-

sion it was deemed acceptable in all areas.

Signature Stamp - Payroll Use Request

It was moved by Schaefer and seconded by Perleberg to approve the use of the signature stamp for payroll use. Motion carried with no dissenting votes. BM Skogen requested the use of the signature stamp for payroll items under \$500. This will simplify the payroll process, while staying in line with other use the stamp has been previously approved for.
