Members of the Beach High School Band traveled to Fargo, ND on Oct. 3 for the annual Woodwind Day hosted by North Dakota State University (NDSU). Woodwind Day gives students the opportunity to work on individual and ensemble playing, as well as connect with other students who are passionate about music.

Band Director Kirstyn Bohn brought freshmen Avery Moe (clarinet) and Alyson Weishaar (alto saxophone), along with sophomore Avery Olstad (tenor saxophone).

The students all performed in the same high school ensemble, playing alongside the NDSU Symphonic Band. During rehearsals, they were split up into sectionals based on their instrument.

“When I was a student at Dickinson State, we had an annual Woodwind Day. Since DSU cut the music department, I felt the need to find an opportunity for our students to still experience an event like this, so we headed to Fargo,” Bohn said. “After we registered, I found out the clinicians

were my previous teachers from my hometown . . . It was exciting for my students to meet influential teachers in my life who also gave these students coaching on their instruments.”

Bohn continued, “Our students did a great job being leaders in their sections . . . Each student challenged themselves by learning these pieces and being prepared for a performance in one day.”

“The experience was really fun, and I learned a lot of new things about woodwinds and saxophones,” Weishaar said in a separate interview. “My favorite part of Woodwind Day was getting to play with the college band.”

“We got to experience seeing college students and professors

play their instruments and learned new ways to make a piece more musical,” Moe added. “Going to Woodwind Day taught me many things about my instrument and new ways to practice them.”
