REGULAR MEETING OF CASS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
MAY 19, 2025

- MEETING CALLED TO ORDER**  
Vice Chairman Tim Flakoll called the meeting to order at 3:30 PM with all members present as follows: Duane Breitting, Jim Kapitan, Tim Flakoll, and Joel Vettel in person and Tony Grindberg via Microsoft Teams.
- PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**  
Jim Kapitan led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- MINUTES APPROVED**  
*MOTION, passed*  
Mr. Vettel moved and Mr. Breitting seconded that the minutes of the previous meeting be approved as written. Motion carried.
- AGENDA, Order approved**  
*MOTION, passed*  
Mr. Kapitan moved and Mr. Breitting seconded to amend the order of the agenda and move item 2. Abatement Application to after item 4. Purchase of culverts for County Road 25. Motion carried.
- CONSENT AGENDA APPROVED**  
*MOTION, passed*  
Mr. Breitting moved and Mr. Vettel seconded to approve the consent agenda as follows: On roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.
  - Authorize purchase of office and conference room furniture for the Jail Addition from Fluid Interiors in the amount of \$29,695.16.
  - Authorize purchase of employee appreciation event with Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks in the amount of \$5,500.

  - Grant site authorization permits to conduct games of chance under license issued by the North Dakota Attorney General's Office for the period of July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026, for Veterans, Incorporated at Bronco Bar in Chaffee, North Dakota.
  - Contract approval—Addendum to Joint Exercise of Peace Officer Duties for the Metro Street Crimes Unit.
- PUBLIC COMMENT**  
Mr. Grindberg asked for public comment and hearing none, moved on to the regular agenda items.
- RESOLUTION #2025-08, Public hearing on host approval for the issuance of revenue bonds for Sanford approved**  
Ronni A. Martin of Chapman and Culter LLP on behalf of Sanford Health, was present via Microsoft Teams to discuss a request for the Commission to adopt a resolution and host a public hearing on host approval for the issuance of revenue bonds on behalf of South Dakota Health and Educational Facilities Authority and authorize the publication of a notice of the public hearing. Ms. Martin said Cass County is not liable for the tax-exempt bonds, Cass County is asked to hold a public hearing to meet federal income tax requirements for Sanford to be in a position to issue tax-exempt bonds and use a portion of the bonds within Cass County.

Mr. Flakoll opened the public hearing on host approval for the issuance of revenue bonds on behalf of South Dakota Health and Educational Facilities Authority. Hearing no comments, Mr. Flakoll closed the public hearing.

*MOTION, passed*  
Mr. Kapitan moved and Mr. Breitting seconded to adopt resolution #2025-08 approving the issuance of revenue bonds by the South Dakota Health and Educational Facilities Authority for the benefit of Sanford and authorizing the execution of certain documents in connection therewith. On roll call vote, the motion carried with Commissioners Grindberg, Breitting, Flakoll, and Kapitan voting “yes” and Commissioner Vettel “abstaining”.
- HOMEARD ANIMAL SHELTER, Update on shelter and new facility project**  
Homeward Animal Shelter (HAS) Executive Director, Tasha Haug, was present to discuss an update on HAS operations and a new facility project. Ms. Haug said HAS rescues 75% to 85% of all unclaimed animals from the Fargo pound and in 2024 adopted out 1,386 pets to forever homes. She said the current HAS facility was built in 1990 and is 2,268 square feet with 9 dog kennels and 28 cat kennels. Ms. Haug said temporary kennels are used as needed and at any one time, 70% to 80% of animals in HAS care are in foster homes. She said HAS 5.8 acres of land north of 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue North and 45<sup>th</sup> Street North to construct a new 20,000 square foot plus facility. She said the new facility is needed due to the rising number of animals in need and will include a veterinary office.

HAS Board Member, Amy Ruley was present and thanked the Commission and community for HAS support. She said HAS works to meet the rising needs of animals and prevent adoptable animals from being put down.

Mr. Kapitan asked if HAS has a veterinarian on staff. Ms. Haug said HAS has two volunteer veterinarians, however, in most cases, animals are taken to a veterinarian clinic just as anyone else in the community takes their pet to the clinic. Mr. Vettel said non-profits are vital in the community to help with animal shelter and without them the burden would fall on local governments.

Ms. Haug said HAS is the only group in the Fargo-Moorhead Area with a program designed to take in feral cats, it is called “Barn Buddies” where cats are neutered or spayed, given vaccinations, and placed in a barn/home that has the right care. She said without the program, the community could see negative results given the fact that in seven years, one pair of cats and their offspring could produce over 420,000 kittens and there are viruses that can be passed from stray animals to pets.
- ROAD, Purchase of County Road 26 culverts approved**  
County Engineer, Kyle Litchy was present to discuss a request to purchase culverts for County Road 26. He said the existing culverts 70 to 80 years old and need to be replaced. He said the culverts will be replaced from Interstate 29 to State Highway 18. Mr. Litchy said the Highway Department received two quotes for the purchase and the culverts from TrueNorth Steel are the lowest cost and meet timelines for delivery. He said the request is to purchase the culverts from TrueNorth Steel in the amount of \$129,948.94.  
*MOTION, passed*  
Mr. Kapitan moved and Mr. Breitting seconded to authorize County Engineer to accept the quote from TrueNorth Steel in the amount of \$129,948.94 . On roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.
- ABATEMENT, Denied for Amanda Jensen**  
An abatement application was submitted by Amanda Jensen for a property located at 1280 Goldenwood Drive in West Fargo for the 2023 and 2024 tax years. Ms. Jensen was present at the meeting via Microsoft Teams and discussed her appeal. She provided the Commission with an article from the Fargo Forum, estimated home values from Zillow, Realtor.com, an appraisal of the property, and comparable property sales. She said the information provided supports a lower value than the \$801,900 and \$824,500 that the City of Fargo Assessing Office is recommending.

City of West Fargo Assessor, Paul Fracassi was present and said the value of the property was brought up to \$801,900 in 2023 after the home was finished construction and a pool was added. He said the West Fargo Assessor's Office provided comparable sales and concluded the value for 2023 and 2024 is supported. He said he requested to do an onsite review of the property and the applicant denied the request for review. Mr. Fracassi said the request of the Commission today is to deny the abatement application and uphold the 2023 and 2024 value.

Mr. Flakoll asked for any further comment on the application and hearing none, requested a motion on the proposed application.

*MOTION, passed*  
Mr. Kapitan moved and Mr. Breitting seconded to reject abatement applications #4568 and #4593 and uphold the value of \$801,900 for 2023 and \$824,500 for 2024. Discussion: Mr. Flakoll asked for clarification on the motion. Commission Assistant, Taylor Kaushagen clarified the intent of the motion is to retain the current value of \$801,900 for 2023 and \$824,500 for 2024. Commissioners were in agreement this is the intent of the motion. On roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Vettel moved and Mr. Breitting seconded to approve Voucher No. 349802 through Voucher No. 350093 for a total of \$3,651,498.64. On roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.

County Finance Director, Brandy Madrigga was present and said budgets are now available for departments. She said all budget requests for 2026 are due to the Finance Office by June 30, 2025.
