# Final Notice and Public Explanation of a Proposed Activity in a 100-Year/500-year Floodplain

To: All interested Agencies, Groups, and Individuals

This is to give notice that the City of Georgetown under Part 58 has con-ducted an evaluation as required by Executive Order 11988, in accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR 55.20 Subpart C Procedures for Making Determinations on Floodplain Management. The activity is funded under the Small Cities Development Program, CDAP-23-0084-O-FY24. The proposed project is located in the City of Georgetown, Clay County. Georgetown is planning improvements to their drinking water distribution system and an in-terconnection line to the City of Perley which will allow them to link into the West Central Regional Water Teatment is inadequate, and the water distribu-tion lines are past their serviceable life and require replacement. This project will include approximately 65 miles of 6-inch watermain from a connection will include approximately 6.5 miles of 6-inch watermain from a connection point between the City of Perly and the City of Georgetown, including prop-er FEMA-approved installation under the flood levee, installation of a meter building, and 1,000 feet of 6-inch watermain, new valves, and piping to con-nect to the City's distribution system. The proposed project will not alter the floodplain, and the improvements will not be subject to impacts from flooding. Approximately 61.59 acres are in the floodplain.

The City of Georgetown has considered the following alternatives and mitiation measures to be taken to minimize adverse impacts and to restore and preserve natural and beneficial values:
Option A This option would involve the construction activities as described

above. It is anticipated that the construction activities will not impact the flood-plain due to trenchless construction methods used in critical portions of the project. Potential direct and indirect impacts include:

- Increased reliability and lifespan of infrastructure systems.
   Resolution of the issues with current infrastructure.
- Reduced risk of catastrophic failure of infrastructure systems

 Option B-This option would involve rerouting the proposed infrastructure improvements to avoid all contact with the floodplain in the project area. This option is cost prohibitive.

 Option C - The "No Action" alternative is not practicable. The age and failing condition of Georgetown's infrastructure will continue to create hazards to persons, property, and the environment. This option would involve no construction activities and would not provide improvement to Georgetown's in-frastructure thereby providing no improvement to the health and safety of residents

The City of Georgetown has reevaluated the alternatives to building in the floodplain and has determined that it has no practicable alternative. Environmental files that document compliance with steps 3 through 6 of Executive Order 11988 are available for public inspection, review, and copying upon request at the times and location delineated in the last paragraph of this notice for receipt of comments. This activity will have no significant impact on the environment for the following reasons:

The construction activities will not impact the floodplain due to trenchless construction methods used in critical portions of the project

There are three primary purposes for this notice. First, people who may be affected by activities in the floodplain and those who have an interest in the protection of the natural environment should be given an opportunity to express their concerns and provide information about these areas. Second, an adequate public notice program can be an important public educational tool. The dissemination of information and request for public comments about floodplains can facilitate and enhance Federal efforts to reduce the risks and impacts associated with the occupancy and modification of these special ar-eas. Third, as a matter of fairness, when the Federal government determines it will participate in actions taking place in floodplains, it must inform those who may be put at greater or continued risk.
