Allo Towers proposes the construction of a guyed style telecommunications tower within a 50' x 50' compound approximately 0.11 miles south-southwest of 26th Ave. NE & Hwy. 52, Martin, Wells County, ND. 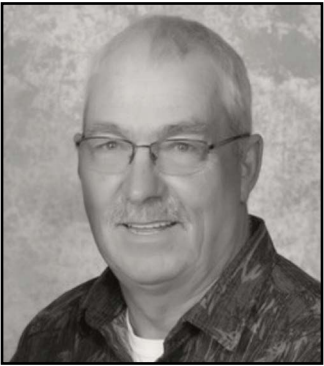
