November 12, 2025

The regular monthly meeting of the Flasher City Commission was called to order by President Meyhoff at 7:00 pm. Commissioners Kramer, Ternes, Gross, and Gessey were present. Also, present were Stacey Glatt, Daniele Rich, Caleb Cofer, Allison Cofer, and Katie Gross

Meyhoff asked all to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance and reminded all we will be using Roberts Rule of Order.

Public Comment Session was held: Allison Cofer took a moment to thank the city and Commissioner Ternes for the repairs to the street in front of her home.

Motion approving October 8 meeting minutes. (Gross/Gessey). With all voting in favor, motion carried.

Motion to sell city shop and lots (4 lots total) for \$10,000 to Caleb Cofer with stipulations of easement for drainage and access to remove documents and items owned by the city when accessible. (Ternes/Gessey).

With all voting in favor, motion carried.

Motion to approve posting ad in paper and on facebook offering stray cats to farmers. (Ternes/Gross). With all voting in favor, motion carried.

Reminder to residents that the Commission will be hosting a Christmas Party at 6:30 pm on December 10, prior to the city meeting. All are welcome to come enjoy some snacks and visit with their commission.

Motion to approve liquor license for the Branded Bar and Grill. (Gessey/Kramer). With all voting in favor, motion carried. Motion to approve St. Lawrence Game Permit. (Gross/Gessey). Meyhoff abstain. With all voting in favor, motion carried.

Commission received notification that due to state funding loss, there will be annual charges for the City app starting next year. More information to follow as the time comes closer.

Motion to approve changing the lock to the city shop to a keypad entry and purchase two of the MENGQI for \$118.99 each. (Ternes/Gessey). With all voting in favor, motion carried. Motion to apply for the

Block Grant for the street lights. (Gessey/Ternes). With all voting in favor, motion carried. Motion to accept the proposal from Schaff electric to conduct the work for the street lights. (Gessey/Ternes). With all voting in favor, motion carried.

Discussed condition of the road in the landfill and will need to plan for repairs prior to re-open in the spring.

Motion to approve the contract with the ND Industrial Commission regarding the Outdoor Heritage Fund. (Kramer/Gessey). Roll call vote – all aye. With all voting in favor, motion carried. Motion to designate City Auditor as the Title VI Correspondent. (Gross/Kramer). Roll call vote – all aye. With all voting in favor, motion carried.

Motion to approve days off in December for the auditor. (Kramer/Ternes). With all voting in favor, motion carried.

Motion approving checks written. (Gessey/Kramer) With all voting in favor, motion carried. Motion to approve October financials. (Kramer/Gessey). With all voting in favor, motion carried. Motion to approve Purchase Order 85450. (Gessey/Kramer). With all voting in favor, motion carried.
