of North Dakota is anticipated to decline about \$500,000 based on declining enrollment and changes to the formula used by the North Dakota Department of Education to distribute state funding.

Combined federal and state funding provides 70.9% of the Jamestown Public School District’s revenue budget.

Local property tax provides about 29% of the district’s revenue.

“Our tax levy is at 102 mills,” Lech said. “That has been consistent for a number of years.”

A property tax of 102 mills costs a homeowner about \$918 in property taxes annually for home valued \$200,000. The

property tax of 102 mills costs a commercial property owner \$1,020 annually for commercial property valued at \$200,000.

The school board also unanimously approved a Certificate of Levy to be sent to the Stutsman County auditor to be included in the property tax calculations for tax bills that will be distributed in December.

Lech said the budget for the 2025-2026 school year is appropriate based on the students’ current needs.

“I’m worried long term based on our decreasing enrollment,” he said. “We need to find more efficiencies in the budget. This is not sustainable. We need to look for long-term changes.”
