Dakota.”

Budd-Falen, a lawyer from Cheyenne, Wyoming, said that as governor, Burgum urged the federal government to “find a way to manage the wild horses in a manner and herd size that supports genetic diversity and protects the environmental integrity and capacity of the park for current and future generations.”

Researchers found 79% of mares in the park that were given two hand-injected doses of GonaCon four years apart did not regain fertility, leading to concerns the drug could cause sterility.

Wild horse advocates have asked the park to use PZP, a birth-control drug that is reversible and does not have the sterility risk that GonaCon poses. The park service, however, prefers to use GonaCon because PZP must be administered yearly, Budd-Falen wrote.

But the park appears to be regularly giving mares GonaCon, Kman said.

Except for a few that were too young, all mares of reproductive age were given the drug at a round-up last fall, and staff also injected the drug by high-velocity dart gun because some mares were still giving birth, she said.

In April, Sen. John Hoeven, R-N.D., introduced legislation to protect the wild horses in the park, including a requirement that a herd of at least 150 horses must be maintained. The bill also seeks to bar the removal of any horses “except as part of a plan to improve genetic diversity, in the case of an emergency or to protect public health and safety.”

Kman would like to offer amendments to tighten the legislation. “There’s too many loopholes here and too many things that are left to interpretation,” she said.

Hoeven’s bill requires the park to develop a plan to manage the horses within 120 days of the bill’s enactment. The bill also requires the park to make annual public reports regarding the wild horse herd’s “population, structure and

health.”

“Where’s there any accountability to the park?” Kman asked. Federal legislation protecting the wild horses at Shackleford Banks, a barrier island and part of the Cape Lookout National Seashore in North Carolina, must report to the Foundation for Shackleford Horses, a nonprofit that works with the park to manage the horses.

“Why can’t we have that for our horses?” Kman said.

Hoeven met recently with Frost and discussed a variety of topics important to Theodore Roosevelt National Park, including the senator’s legislation to maintain the horse herd, Hoeven

spokesperson Alex Finken said.

“Our legislation requires the NPS (National Park Service) to maintain a wild horse herd of no fewer than 150 horses, without exception,” Finken said. “We have worked hard to draft legislation that has broad support, so we want to be careful that any changes don’t jeopardize the bill’s passage.”

Hoeven is working to schedule a hearing on the bill, co-sponsored by Sen. Tim Kaine, D-Va., this fall, Finken said. Even with the partial government shutdown, Hoeven expects the bill will have a hearing this fall, he said.
