Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received for the Park Entrance Road Project (REBID), SRF-0041(018), PCN 22803, located in the City of Milnor, North Dakota. Bids will be received On-Line ONLY through QuestCDN vBid. Bids will be received by 10:00 AM (CDT) on June 3, 2025. Mailed or hand delivered bids will NOT be opened or considered. Please submit your bid for this project by the following:

1. Submitted through QuestCDN Online Bidding.

All bids submitted will be opened and read aloud via video conference at 10:15 AM (CDT) on June 3, 2025. The project consists of a 700-foot-long and 22-foot-wide Hot Bituminous Pavement Roadway with an Aggregate Base.

Each bid will be submitted on the basis of a cash payment for work. It will be enclosed in a sealed envelope addressed to the above-mentioned City Auditor and shall be designated that the bid is for “Park Entrance Road Project (REBID), SRF-0041(018), PCN 22803, Milnor, North Dakota.” The bid shall be accompanied by a Bidder’s Bond in a separate envelope in the amount of five percent (5%) of the full amount of the bid, executed by the Bidder as Principal and by a Surety Company authorized to do business in North Dakota. If the Principal’s bid is accepted by the City of Milnor and the contract awarded, the principal, within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award, will be required to execute and effect a contract in accordance with the terms of the principal’s bid and any requirements and conditions of the Owner.

A Contractor’s Bond, as required by Section 48-01.2-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, shall be included with the executed Contract Documents. The Bid Security shall be as required in Section 48-01.2-05 of the North Dakota Century Code.

All bidders must be licensed for the

highest amount of their bids, as required by Section 43-07-07 of the North Dakota Century Code and a copy of the license or certificate of renewal thereof issued shall be enclosed in the required bid bond envelope.

No bid will be read or considered which does not fully comply with the above provisions as to Bond and Licenses, and any deficient bid submitted will be resealed and returned to the Bidder immediately.

The OWNER retains the right to reject any or all of the bids submitted and to waive any informality in any bid and to hold all bids for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from said date of opening and to hold the three low bids and bid securities for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from said date of bid opening.

The work on the improvements is to commence upon a date to be specified by the OWNER, notice of which will be given to the successful bidder ten (10) days in advance of the start of construction. The Contractor will be required to commence construction, and in an approved sequence, complete the project by October 4, 2025.
