The **Budget Hearing** began at 6:00 p.m. in the NS FACS Room.

The final budget levy from the last two fiscal years was 97.76 mills. Currently, we are unable to determine a mill levy so the Certificate of Levy in dollars levied totals \$918,780.58.

The 2025-2026 Certificate of Levy is based on the new guidelines from the state HB1176 Cap Calculation Worksheet.
