SEPTEMBER 30, 2025**

The **Budget Hearing** began at 6:00 p.m. in the NS FACS Room.

Board members Kris Beck, Sean Anderson and Lucas Jacobson were present. Board members absent from the hearing were Zachary Johnson and Andrew Greenmyer. Also present was Supt. Kara Munro and Business Mgr. Donna Anderson.

No public attendees were present with oral or written comments regarding the 2025-2026 budget.

Discussion was held on the preliminary to final budget changes. The 2025 final valuation estimates were not received so the budget is based on dollars levied from the 2024 valuation of \$9,124,593. The final budget levy from the last two fiscal years was 97.76 mills. Currently, we are unable to determine a mill levy so the Certificate of Levy in dollars levied totals \$918,780.58.

The 2025-2026 Certificate of Levy is based on the new guidelines from the state HB1176 Cap Calculation Worksheet.
