

Lady Lions perform well in Miller Wrestling Tournament

Dawes, Coronado and Mittleider place 2nd for LHMBS

Aleena Dawes, Jaycelin Coronado and Hope Mittleider of Linton/Hazelton-Moffit-Braddock/Strasburg each placed second in their respective weight divisions of the Bob Lager Invitational Girls Wrestling Tournament, Jan. 9, in Miller, South Dakota. LHMBS was among a dozen teams in the tournament, with all of the remaining teams being from South Dakota, with the exception of Ellendale/Edgeley-Kulm. The Lady Lions finished in seventh place in the team standings with 50 points. Dawes reached the championship match in the 100-pound division with a pin (:44) over Kadee Kutz (:44) of Miller/Highmore/Harrold in the semifinals. Dawes then lost a tough, 3-2 decision to Mira Wagner of Sioux Valley in the finals. Coronado pinned (1:00) Siya Peterson of Miller/Highmore/Harrold in the 130-pound quarterfinals, and then reached the finals with a pin (3:38) over Clark/Willow Lake's Chyanne Guerdet in the semi-finals. In the championship match, Coronado was pinned by Sisseton's Vi Anderson in 3:48. Mittleider received a bye in the 140-pound quarterfi-

nals, and then pinned (1:36) Mia Klein of Douglas in the semi-finals. In the final match, Skye Guthmiller of Sioux Valley won a 7-4 decision over Mittleider. Two other Lady Lions participated in the tournament. Ashtyn Leier participated in the 105-pound division, where she fell (3:15) to Ellendale/Edgeley-Kulm's Marlee Miller in the quarterfinals, before being eliminated with a pin (4:07) by Miller/Highmore/Harrold's Morah Schwartzendruber in the consolation round. Kynslee Steckler participated in the 155-pound division, where she lost by fall (:55) to Ipswich/Bowdle's Jocelyn Tran in the quarterfinals, before falling (:28) to Izzi Evans of Douglas in the consolation round. Clark/Willow Lake took the team championship with 101.5 points, and Sioux Valley was the runner-up with 98. Douglas (83), Sisseton (72) and host Miller/Highmore/Harrold (67.5) rounded out the top five teams.

Four LHMBS grapplers place in Bob Lager Tournament

Gerhardt, Shea place in top four individually

Four Linton/Hazelton-Moffit-Braddock/Strasburg grapplers placed in the Bob Lager Invitational Wrestling Tournament, held Jan. 10, in Miller, South Dakota. Cash Gerhardt went 4-1 and placed third at 113, while Aidan Shea went 4-2 and placed fourth at 138, and Brody Ptacek (3-3 at 126) and Michael Bosch (3-3 at 175) each placed sixth for the Lions. Emiliano Castillo (157) and Skyler Hoff-Wald (285) also participated in the tournament for LHMBS, but they did not place. LHMBS was among 19 teams in the tournament, with all of the remaining teams being in the South Dakota Class B Division. The Lions finished in 12th place in the team standings with 63.5 points. Bon Homme/Avon took the team championship with 238 points, and Clark/Willow Lake was the runner-up with 132.5. Philip/Kodaka Area/Wall (129.5), Parkston (114) and Wessington Springs/Woonsocket/Wolsey-Wessington (113.5) rounded out the top five teams.
