CITY OF ZEELAND CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC MEETING FINALIZE WATER PROJECT MARCH 10, 2026

Order was called by Mayor Lacher at 6:30 p.m.

Roll was called. Ryan Pfeifer (P); Todd Dohn (P); Travis Stahl (P) and Alfred Schumacher (A). There were no public appearances.

The purpose of this meeting was to finalize the water project. Updates were made to the lagoon system and upgrades to the water tower and controls to prevent the tower from freezing and have better monitoring.

The project was pushed back due to some issues, but this actually saved the city money.

Lagoon pumping station received new control panel and a new auto generator system. Water tower updates were a circulating pump, control panel and mixer and VFD pumps and WIFI which allows the system to be monitored at all times.

At this time the city has met its requirements to meet the regulations to receive the grant funding. The total cost of the project at this time is \$389,979.16 which the city received grants from CDBG \$315,500; DWR Cost-share \$38,522.25; DWSRF Loan (2% interest) \$34,456.91. Cost to city at this time is \$35,956.91. Final bills will be sent in to DWSRF which is a 90% grant. City was very fortunate to get these grants which helped pay for the project.
