Final balance change order #3 was submitted for the rehabilitation project. Decrease of \$65,102.99. Motion to approve by Councilman Faul, second by Councilwoman Wentworth. Carried by all.

The council informed Michael they will not be paying for the \$20,000.00 equipment rental fee CC Steel incurred without the council's approval.

Several change orders to be submitted at the April meeting to reflect the council's decisions.

Ordinance 2026-01 Floodplain 2nd reading. Motion to approve as read by Councilwoman Wentworth, second by Councilman Thorp. Carried by all.

The brush pile by the creek through town has been burnt and is no longer a threat to the bridge downstream in the event of flooding.

New Business:

NDDOT submitted a floodplain permit application for repair and resurfacing of Hwy 52 near Flaten Coulee. Approved.

Kenmare News asked if the city wanted to be a sponsor on the Berthold Bombers "congratulations" page this week for making state. Cost is \$45.00. Motion to approve by Councilman Faul, second by Councilman Thorp. Carried by all.

The snow pusher blade is in need of repair and parts. Total cost to be less than \$3,500.00. Councilman Faul made a motion to approve. Second by Councilwoman Wentworth. Carried by all.

The warranty on the new loader purchased last year has expired. Several options were discussed. The council decided to purchase a Premier warranty through Butler Machinery for 72 months (1,000 hours) for \$1,690.00.
