“What must I do to be saved?” This was a question that was asked on the day the Church was born in Acts 2:37-38. This was when they realized they had just killed Christ. This is the most important question that anyone can ever ask. Yet almost without exception when a person asks “are you saved?” the most common answer is “I hope so” or “I think so”. You can KNOW that you are saved! Not because you are saying you are good enough, but because you have faith that God has given the perfect sacrifice for our sins. God is always faithful in carrying out His promises. The question is – do you trust God?

We should trust God because He has always kept His word. Noah built the ark and God waited to send the flood. Once he was in the ark, God shut the door and the rain began. Noah

had to believe enough to build the ark to be saved. Our job is much easier. In Acts 2 it simply tells us “To repent and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.” If you have the Holy Spirit, you are saved. They already believed or they would not have interrupted Peter’s message and asked what they needed to do.

But this is an active belief. Don’t fall for the trap where we are told that just believing is enough. Satan believes this and is completely lost. Faith is not just believing. It is an active living thing that compels us to live for God. We waste so much of life and rob ourselves of joy because we do not follow God’s simple plan of salvation. Your joy will be so great, and depression is driven away when we trust God and except this free gift. Tell the world you are saved because we have a great and loving God!
