The Oakes Public School is holding their annual school board election in conjunction with the proposed school bond referendum. In years past, the elections were held at the school. New legislation requires school bond elections to be held during the primary or general elections. These elections are conducted by the Oakes Public Schools County Auditors. That means that if your residence resides in the Oakes Public School District in Dickey County, you can vote at either the Oakes Armory or the Ellendale Church of the Nazarene. Polls will be open from 8 AM-7 PM.

If your residence resides in the Oakes Public School District in Ransom County you can vote at the Ransom County Expo Center or the Enderlin City Auditor Office. These polling locations will be open from 9 AM-7 PM.

If your residence resides in the Oakes Public School District in Sargent County you can vote at the Forman City Hall. The polls will be open from 8 AM- 7 PM.

If your residence resides in the Oakes Public School District in LaMoure County, you can vote at the Edgeley National Guard Armory or the Bank North Mall Community Room. These polling locations will be open from 9 AM-7 PM.

If you would need an absentee ballot, please complete an Absentee/Mail Ballot Application SFN 51468 and either mail or deliver it to your county auditor. They will process the application and send you a ballot that corresponds with your location.
