## Cloud seeding operations summary for June 8-14, 2026

BISMARCK, N.D. – After a round of severe thunderstorms last Tuesday, a cold front brought cooler and more stable weather conditions to southwestern North Dakota for the remainder of the week.

In the District 1 operations area, which includes Bowman and part of Slope Counties, aircraft flew two operational flights for rain enhancement purposes last week.

Southwestern North Dakota should see near normal high temperatures in the mid to upper 70s and periodic chances for showers and thunderstorms this week.

Radar facilities in Bowman operate around the clock during the NDCMP. Radar images can be viewed on the Department of Water Resources' website at <http://www.dwr.nd.gov/arb>. The NDCMP will continue through the end of August.
