

City Council Meeting May 4, 2026

City Office at 7pm BEING PUBLISHED SUBJECT TO THE GOVERNING BODY'S REVIEW AND REVISION Mayor Olson called the meeting to order at 7pm and pledge of allegiance was recited. Council members present were Larson, Grundstrom, Weimer, T. Van Camp, Nelson and Halcrow. City employees present were Mattice, DeGeldere and Misialek. Others present were Dylan Ensrude with Moore Engineering and Dan Aubol with Colonial Life. Dylan with Moore has been in contact with NDDOT regarding the manhole on Main and Grant and is working with them to see if the city can replace it at this time. After talking with DeGeldere, it is not just the ring, it is the entire structure, therefore that would have to be done with our infrastructure project and not at this time. He has also been in contact with BNSF in regards to the Grant Ave crossing that they are asking for the city to cost share the expense of fixing. He will be seeing if this is something that can be done in conjunction with our infrastructure project in 2027. He will let us know. Dylan also gave us an update on the design reviews and choices for funding. Dan Aubol with Colonial Life gave a short presentation regarding some of what they can offer to city employees at no charge to the

city. Costs would be completely paid for by the employee through payroll deduction. City employees will be able to pick what services they want. He will set up a time to meet with the employees. Misialek gave an update on not having a service available for city wide clean up at this time. Misialek will keep council updated if things change. Discussion was had on the need to do some cosmetic repairs at the community center. Valley Building and Lumber offered to donate some supplies and a motion to use \$4000 from the tourism fund was made by Grundstrom, seconded by Larson, all in favor. Volunteers will be used to paint and such. There are several areas of the dike that need to be repaired. DeGeldere met with several contractors regarding this work. A motion to spend up to \$50,000 from Flood Control to make these repairs was made by Grundstrom, seconded by T. Van Camp, all in favor. Misialek presented the resolution naming Valley News and Views as Drayton's official newspaper. A motion was made by Larson, seconded by T. Van Camp, all in favor. Misialek presented the gaming site authorization submitted by Aggie Foundation to have gaming in Johnny Bravo. Discussion was had and the council would like to see it run by a local organization. No motion was made. Misialek informed the council

that the recycling contract will be expiring July 31, 2026. A discussion was had that we no longer have recycling after this contract expires. This will be discussed at June's meeting when Waste Management sends us a renewal contract. Motion to approve April 13, 2026 council meeting minutes and April 14, 2026 Tax Equalization meeting minutes was made by T. Van Camp, seconded by Nelson, all in favor.
