Board President Allmaras called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m.

Approval of the Agenda

It was moved by Schaefer and seconded by Schumacher to approve the agenda with the addition of Item J, K & L Transportation. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of the May 11th, 2026 regular meeting and May 29th 2026 special meeting minutes

It was moved by Alfstad and seconded by Schaefer to approve the May 11th 2026, regular meeting and May 29th 2026 special meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of the Consent Agenda

It was moved by Schaefer and seconded by Schumacher to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously. The consent agenda consisted of the business manager report, and the bills - general fund of \$26,434.34, and the food service fund of \$5,301.87.

Monthly Committee Reports

The transportation committee met prior to the full board meeting. The committee is bringing forward discussion which has been added to this agenda.

Secondary Principal Hager shared her report with the board.

Elementary Principal Benz was not present this evening. Her report was shared with the board.

Canvas of the 2026 School Board Election

It was moved by Schumacher and seconded by Alfstad to approve the Canvas of the 2026 School Board Election. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. BM Skogen presented the results of the 2026 school board election. New Rockford seat was won by Mike Schaefer, Sheyenne seat was won by Kyle Alfstad, and the Sheyenne seat with a one year term was won by Matt Ystaas on a write-in basis as no one petitioned for the seat on the ballot.

Policy FFE

Extracurricular Participation Requirements Update

It was moved by Schaefer and seconded by Alfstad to approve the update to Policy FFE - Extracurricular Participation Requirements. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. Update to the policy was verbiage change, and removal of one sentence.

Policy GACE Alternative Methods of Credit for High School Graduation and Curriculum Requirements First Read

It was moved by Alfstad and seconded by Schumacher to approve Policy GACE as a first and final read using Policy BCA. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. The Policy allows students to obtain credit for taking relevant portions of the GED assessment to satisfy corresponding graduation requirements.

Policy GACE AR General Education Development Credit for High School Graduations

It was moved by Schaefer and seconded by Schumacher to approve first and final read of Policy GACE-AR. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. Tech Coordinator Amy Cudworth, and Elementary Principal Stacy Benz will attend a school technology and cyber security conference in Reno, Nevada.

NDSBA Contract for Policy Manual Review

It was moved by Schaefer and

seconded by Alfstad to approve the NDSBA Contract for Policy Manual Review. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. Superintendent Becker shared with the board the proposal to work with the NDSBA to review the districts policy manual and turn the policy into a web-based system housed with the NDSBA. In doing so the district would ensure that all policies are up to date, accurate, and meeting all legislative requirements on an annual basis.

Consolidated Application

It was moved by Alfstad and seconded by Schumacher to approve the Consolidated Application as presented. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. On an annual basis the district completes the consolidated application to apply for Title funding. This application is approved by the board prior to its submission the NDDPI.

Business Manager Evaluation

It was moved by Schumacher and seconded by Schaefer to approve the Business Manager evaluation as presented. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. Board Chair Allmaras walked the board through the compiled results of the annual business manager evaluation.

Executive Session

Negotiations Strategy

It was moved by Schaefer and seconded by Schumacher to enter into executive session for the purpose of negotiations strategy. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. Executive session was entered into at 8:32. The meeting resumed at 9:13

Administrative Contracts

It was moved by Schaefer and seconded by Schumacher to approve Administrative Contracts as presented. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

Transportation

It was moved by Alfstad and seconded by Allmaras to approve

the bid proposal for two busses, \$6,500 for the 2000 model and \$17,500 for the 2017 model. Motion carried by unanimous roll call

vote. The Zeeland school district is closing and is selling its assets. Board member Schaefer drove to view the busses, which would add a cost effective asset to the districts transportation needs. Bids will be submitted for each as noted.

Fuel Cards

It was moved by Schaefer and seconded by Schumacher to approve the acquisition of four fuel cards from CenDak. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. Cards will be used at times when CenDak is closed. This will allow drivers to fill district vehicles as needed to allow for more efficient departure times, and less personal reimbursements.

Transportation Route Contracts

Discussion only. Proposed changes to the contracted transportation route contracts were discussed. Topic was informative only to the board. Contracts will be created and sent out to current contracted transportation

drivers.
