

Swimming pool to open soon

Opening soon for the summer, hours at the Golden Valley County Swimming Pool are Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 1 to 7 p.m.; Tuesday and Thursday from 1 to 5:45 p.m. and 6:30 to 8:15 p.m.; and Saturday and Sunday from 2 to 7 p.m. The pool's Facebook page will be updated should there be a reason the pool is unable to open. Children five years

or under must be accompanied by a guardian age 12 or older at all times at the pool. They swim for free with a paying guardian. Family and single season passes are available for purchase. Those without passes will be charged a daily fee. Family Nights are Tuesday and Thursday. Children must have a guardian over 18 with them to be able to swim. Lap Swim is Monday, Wednesday and Friday

from 6:30 to 8 a.m. There is a fee for this special swim time. Sign up day for swimming lessons is June 15 at Beach City Hall from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m. Sign up sheets can be found at the swimming pool, City Hall, Golden Valley County Library, the City of Beach website and the pool's Facebook page. There will be four sessions: July 6-10, July 13-17, July 20-24 and July 27-31. Each class

will have no more than five students. If there is enough interest, Mommy & Me classes will be held July 13-17 at 11:30 a.m. Private parties are available from 7 to 9 p.m. every day except for Tuesday and Thursday. There is a fee and lifeguards will have to be asked beforehand to work at the party. For more information, contact Seth Bishop at 701-260-5659.

The proposed amendment is summarized as follows: constitutional amendments would be limited to one subject. The Secretary of State shall not approve an initiative petition for circulation if the Secretary determines that the proposed amendment comprises more than one subject. Additionally, the legislative assembly is required to limit proposed amendments to the constitution to one subject.</small> | |
