Notice is hereby given that the Adams County Primary Election will be held on Tuesday June 9th, 2026.

The filing deadline for county and city offices is 4:00 p.m. on Monday, April 6th, 2026.

Every candidate for public office must file an Affidavit of Candidacy and a Statement of Interest form with the applicable filing officer at the same time he or she files their Petition/Certificate of Nomination. Candidates for county offices must file their petitions with the County Auditor. Petitions for county offices must contain signatures of not less than 2% of the votes cast for the same office in the last election. City offices must contain signatures of not less than 10% of the votes cast for the same office in the last election. City candidates must file with their respective City Auditor and are not required to file an Affidavit of Candidacy.

The following federal, state, and county offices will be on the Primary Election ballot:

COUNTY: County Commissioner (1 position 4- year term); County State's Attorney (1 position 4-year term); County Auditor/Treasurer (1 position 4-year term); County Sheriff (1 position 4-year term); County Recorder (1 position 4-year term) Official County Newspaper

HETTINGER CITY: Hettinger City Mayor (1 position 4-year term); Hettinger City Council (1 positions 4- year term); Hettinger City Council (1 position 2-year unexpired term) Hettinger City Park Board (3 positions 4-year terms)

The Hettinger School District, Hettinger City, Reeder City, Bucyrus City, and Haynes City will also be conducting their elections in conjunction with the Primary Election on June 9th, 2026. Please contact the Hettinger School District Business Manager or your City Auditor for more information.

Adams County will be conducting the upcoming elections with one polling location (Adams County

Courthouse, 602 Adams Avenue, Hettinger ND between the hours of 9 am and 7 pm on Election Day) A "Vote by Mail" option is also available, applications will be mailed from the office of the County Auditor/Treasurer. Persons not receiving an application may obtain one from the Adams County Auditor/Treasurer's office. Applications will also be published in the Adams County Record.

The ND Soybean Council's election for your County Representative will take place by **mail ballot** in March 2026. In March, newly elected county representatives will select a board member of the ND Soybean Council.

On or about **February 17, 2026**, the ND Soybean Council will mail each soybean grower of record in the county an election ballot. For your vote to count, ballots must be filed with the County Extension Agent of the above-named county. The ballot can be hand delivered or mailed to the agent. For your vote to count, the County

Extension Agent must receive the ballot by **March 5, 2026**, or your mailed-in ballot must be postmarked no later than **March 5, 2026**. If you do not receive a ballot in the mail, contact your Adams County Extension Agent at 701-567-2735 or the ND Soybean Council at 701-566-9300 to obtain one.

A producer is defined as: "any person that plants or causes to be planted a soybean crop in which the person has an ownership interest, with intent that upon maturity, the crop will be harvested; will have met the requirements of the above stated during the next available growing season or has met these requirements during the immediately preceding growing season. The term does not include an organic producer that has been exempted from the payment of assessments in accordance with federal law."



