

Bears come up short on home field

Amid swirling winds and a light drizzle, the Hettinger American Legion Post #115 Bears began the home portion of its summer schedule on Thursday in Hettinger, falling behind early en route to a 10-1 defeat at the hands of the Garrison Titans.

First baseman Oscar Perkins had two hits and shortstop Nick Dobitz had an RBI double for Hettinger but it wasn't enough to overcome the Titans, which busted out of the gate with eight runs in the first four innings and never looked back.

"Garrison is one of the more-veteran teams

in the region, having brought back four players who played college ball last year," explained Hettinger head coach Nolan Dix.

"We had some good innings but crucial errors cost us numerous runs," Dix added. "We had a tough time with the pitches they threw at us."

Hettinger's lone run came in the fifth inning on a double to right field off the bat of Dobitz. Starting pitcher Owen Praus hurled one inning, striking out two and allowing just one earned run in the loss. Praus left the game after being struck by a line drive in his non-throwing hand in that first inning. Robert Morris

threw 3.2 innings of relief, striking out six and allowing six runs. He was pinned with the loss.

One element that was particularly disruptive was Garrison's running game, which tallied nine stolen bases in the game.

The loss was one of two on the day and dropped the team's early season record to 2-4.

The week ended on a similarly route note on Monday when Beulah jumped out to a huge early lead before sending Hettinger home with a 10-run loss, 17-7.
