to around 75, while overnight lows remain in the upper 50s. Gusty south-east winds near 20 mph could accompany stronger storms. Residents with outdoor plans should stay alert for changing weather conditions.

Sunday: Unsettled weather continues with scattered thunderstorms possible throughout the day. Highs will top out near 73 with morning lows in the mid-50s. Winds will shift to the west at 10 to 15 mph. While not everyone will see rain, occasional storms could interrupt outdoor activities.

Monday: Conditions begin to improve as partly cloudy skies return. Temperatures will rebound into the mid-70s with overnight lows near 52. West-southwest winds around 15 mph will help dry things out, and only a

slight chance of precipitation remains.

Tuesday: Sunshine makes a stronger comeback with mostly sunny skies and warmer temperatures. Afternoon highs are expected to approach 80 after a cool start in the lower 50s. West winds around 15 to 20 mph will persist, but dry weather should prevail.

Wednesday: Summer heat builds by midweek as mostly sunny skies push temperatures into the mid-80s. Morning lows will begin in the upper 50s before southwest winds around 10 to 15 mph help usher in the warmest day of the forecast period. Aside from a slight chance of an isolated shower, conditions look favorable for outdoor activities.
