ABBREVIATED NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES RELATING TO N.D.A.C. CHAPTER 75-02-13 FAMILY PAID CAREGIVER PROGRAM

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Health and Human Services will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code chapter 75-02-13 relating to definitions, application and eligibility, and administration at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, August 12, 2026, in Bismarck, N.D. in Room 210, located on the second floor of the Judicial Wing of the State Capitol. The proposed changes are effective June 29, 2026, as interim final rules under North Dakota Century Code § 28-32-03(2)(c) to avoid a delay in implementing an appropriations measure (section 2 of 2025 Senate Bill No. 2305); the rules are required for the Department of Health and Human Services to comply with the opinion and order of the Supreme Court for the State of North Dakota in *Ferderer v. North Dakota Department of Health and Human Services*, 2026 ND 81, 34 N.W.3d 168 (N.D. 2026).

Copies of the proposed rules are available for review at human service zone offices and at the state-operated behavioral health clinics. Copies of the proposed rules and the regulatory analysis relating to these rules may be requested by telephoning (701) 328-2311. Short Ribs & Gravy

- Description
- 3 T. olive oil
- 1 large white onion, chopped
- 3 carrots, chopped
- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 8 bone-in beef short ribs
- ¼ up flour, plus more for gravy
- ½ cup dry red wine
- 1 cup beef broth
- 1 T. Worcestershire sauce
- 2 T. tomato paste
- Salt and pepper, to taste
- 3 sprigs fresh thyme
- 2 sprigs fresh rosemary
- Instructions

Using a programmable electric multicooker, select sauté setting. Add 1 T. olive oil. Sauté onion and carrots for a few minutes. Add garlic and continue cooking for 30 seconds. Transfer veggies to a plate.

Season short ribs generously with salt and pepper and allow to come to room temperature. Coat on all sides with flour. Add remaining 2 T. olive oil to multicooker, then sear ribs on all sides to develop browning. Transfer to a plate.

Deglaze with wine, scraping bottom of pot to release browned bits. Bring to a boil and cook 2 minutes. Add beef broth and Worcestershire sauce. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Stir in tomato paste. Return ribs and veggies to pot. Add herbs.

Cover with lid and lock in place. Turn steam release handle to sealing (closed) position. Select manual/pressure cook setting. Cook on high pressure for 45 minutes. (Note: It will take 10 to 15 minutes for cooker to pressurize before the cooking time begins.) After cooking, allow the pressure to release naturally for 15 minutes. (Translation: Do nothing. Let it set for 15 minutes.) Carefully turn steam release handle to venting (open) position, allowing steam to fully escape, about 3 to 5 minutes.

Remove lid, transfer meat to a plate and cover with tinfoil. Remove rosemary and thyme stems. Make a flour slurry, then whisk into sauce until thickened to make a gravy. Serve over mashed potatoes

The City of Steele has received a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) from the State of North Dakota Division of Community Services (DSC). CDBG funds are intended to provide decent housing, suitable living environments and economic opportunities, principally for low/very low-income persons through rehabilitation and preservation, economic/job development and public facilities improvement.

The project and funding level considered was \$153,500.00 for their CDBG Multi-Family Housing Rehab (Prairie View Housing) project.

It is estimated that approximately 100% of the funds benefited low/very low-income persons. Displacement of neighborhood persons or businesses did not occur, and no housing units were demolished or converted as a result of the above-mentioned projects.

A public hearing will be held on August 10th, 2026 at 6:45 p.m., at the Steele City Office, 103 West Broadway, Steele, ND 58482 to obtain citizen views and to respond to proposals and questions related to the performance of The City of Steele in carrying out its community development responsibilities. Written comments are also welcome and must be received at the address below by the close of the public hearing. Oral and written comments will be considered to enhance the City of Steele in carrying out its -community development responsibilities.
