PROPOSAL: New Presidential Library

Jennifer Jackson and Zach Mathern with JLG Architects, a North Dakota firm, presented a slide show presentation on the Presidential Library. Jackson presented on the building and Mathern presented on the materials. They both presented on the overall update of the design and materials. The design of this building is one of a kind – it will blend into the scenery and be as natural as possible. The 1000 square foot building will have a vegetated roof with native grasses. The siding is wood cladding with lots of glass windows to enjoy the view. The 8' boardwalk will be wood decking and/or composite decking. The paving and paths will be asphalt or concrete. The fencing will be wood/wire. There will be planting of native species and prairie restoration. A

copy of the presentation will be attached to the submitted application for reference of the approved materials.

Enders made a motion to approve the building design and material, boardwalk design and material and driveways and walkways unconditional use of concrete and/or asphalt, Lukowski seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Easy Crockpot Beef Tips With Gravy Ingredients

- 2 lbs. beef stew meat
 - 1 can condensed cream on mushroom soup
 - 1 packet brown gravy
 - 1 cup beef broth
 - 1 small onion
 - 1-2 cloves of garlic
 - 1 tablespoon cornstarch or potato flakes
 - Egg Noodles or Mashed Potatoes (prepared)
1. In a medium bowl, combine cream of mushroom soup, gravy mix, beef broth, onion and garlic. Whisk together. It's ok if it's a little lumpy, while it's cooking in the slow cooker., the lumps will mix in.
 2. Place stew meat into a 4 quart crockpot. Pour gravy mixture over beef and gently stir to combine. Cook covered on LOW for 7 hours. Once done cooking, remove beef with slotted spoon and set aside. Stir in Cornstarch or Potato flakes (this will thicken up the gravy)
 3. Replace beef back into crockpot and continue cooking for 5 more minutes with gravy thickens.
 4. Serve over egg noddles or mashed potatoes.
