**Recipe: S'mores Puppy Chow**

**Ingredients:**

- 1 C. semi-sweet chocolate chips
- ½ C. creamy peanut butter
- ¼ C. unsalted butter
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 3 C. Rice Chex cereal
- 6 C. Golden Grahams cereal, divided
- 1 + ½ C. powdered sugar
- 1 C. mini marshmallows
- 1 full size Hershey's Bar

**Directions:**

Place the chocolate chips, peanut butter and butter in a microwavable bowl until smooth. Watch so it doesn't burn. Stir in the vanilla extract.

Put the Chex cereal and 3 cups of the Golden Grahams in a large mixing bowl; pour the chocolate mixture over and toss to coat. Pour the mixture into a large baggie. Add the powdered sugar and seal the bag. Shake until all is coated.

Pour into a large bowl and add the rest of the cereal and marshmallows. Break the candy bar into squares and add to the bowl. Toss to coat.

Store in an airtight container in a cool place.

Tip: for Valentine's Day, add colored heart shaped marshmallows or valentine colored m & m's.
