The NDHP is investigating after 71 year old James Wipf from Fesseden sustained serious injuries while working as a construction zone flagger on Highway 14. 81 year old Dale Olson of Wing attempted to pass a semi and struck Wipf's parked vehicle. Charges are under investigation.

Further details have been revealed in the federal case against former West Fargo school Principal David George, who remains in custody on child sexual abuse and child porn charges. The US Attorney's Office allege George took some of his victims over the state border to South Dakota where the abuse occurred. Two of his victims are anticipated to testify in Georhe's upcoming trial.

North Dakota Department of Natural Resources has announced they will be holding a hearing on June 11 & 12 to review the application submitted by Summit Carbon Solution. The company hopes to install carbon dioxide storage locations in Mercer, Morton, and Oliver county in connection to their five-state pipeline project.

43 year old Ian Cramer, son of North Dakota Senator Kevin Cramer, submitted not guilty pleas to numerous charges including homicide while fleeing law enforcement, the victim being Mercer County Deputy Sheriff Paul Martin. An anticipated four-day trial is scheduled to begin July 16. If found guilty of the homicide charge alone, Cramer could face up to 20 years in prison.

The Grand Forks Police Department has announced it will once again be participating in the latest "Click It or Ticket" campaign in which officers will specifically be looking for seat belt violations. The campaign will run from May 1 to June 2.

A two vehicle crash outside of Leeds has left a Towner woman with non life threatening injuries. The crash

happened Wednesday evening on US Highway 2 when 69 year old Carlotta Schall's vehicle was struck by a vehicle being driven by a 16 year old from Church's Ferry who allegedly couldn't see Schall's vehicle because of a 13 year old passenger obstructing his view. The juveniles were not injured in the crash, and charges are pending.

A former music and choir teacher from Fertile-Beltrami schools will be spending 30 days in county jail after taking a plea deal in a case in which he was accused of sex crimes against a minor. The incidents occurred last July, the victim was 15 years old. Alongside the 30 days, Schrom has also received a three year stayed prison sentence, and will also be placed on supervised probation for 15 years.

The Devils Lake City Commission has announced their next police chief will be Officer James Toso. Toso had recently been serving as the interim police chief prior to his permanent promotion last week.

The Cavalier County Sheriff's Department says a 60 year old Langdon resident Jon Mondor was arrested by authorities just south of Munich Wednesday afternoon. The arrest came after a traffic stop of Mondor's vehicle led to the discovery of drug paraphernalia and suspected methamphetamine. Mondor is expected to make his initial appearance in court on May 9.

32 year old Ilia Grigory Basargin of Fertile, MN has pled not guilty to a charge of second-degree criminal sexual conduct, the alleged victims being two juvenile girls. Basargin was reported to police last April. When speaking to authorities, Basargin claimed he was "wasted" when the alleged incident occurred and claims he cannot account for what actually happened. He's expected back on court in late May.

The Fargo Brewing Company has announced that due to financial shortfalls since the pandemic, they have had to file for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection. The company first began operations in 2010 and intends to keep serving their customers through this transition.

A pair of Canadian women, 39 year old Krystal De Leon, and 32 year old Sarah Sophia Rose are accused of attempting to smuggle about 300 grams of cocaine across the international border. The two were caught by border patrol officials and made their initial appearance in Roseau County court last week. The two made the claim the cocaine wasn't theirs, but authorities say they were allegedly attempting to deliver it to a location in Ontario.

The North Dakota Secretary of State's office has received a new petition which aims to pass a measure on the November ballot that would legalize recreational marijuana for those 21 year old and up. If approved, the petition organizers will be required to gather close to 16K valid signatures by the July 8 deadline to be allowed on the ballot.

A sentence of 27 years and three months in federal prison was issued on Friday for 37 year old St. Michael resident Cody James Belgarde. Last November a jury found Belgarde guilty of the second-degree murder of 17 year old Leroy Chapin and attempting to hide the murder by setting the house his body was in on fire.

Two members of the Spirit Lake Reservation were charged with child neglect and the involuntary manslaughter of three year old Ariana McKay. 28 year old Austin Lester and 35 year old Krissy Hinsley were charged in federal court on Friday. FBI investigations into McKay's death began back in August 2022 after Ariana died in the hospital after drinking a bottle of Tylenol.
