Barnes County Commission January 2, 2024 Valley City, ND 58072

The Barnes County Commission met in regular session on Tuesday, January 2, 2023 with Cindy Schwehr, Vicky Lovell, Bill Carlblom, Pete Paulson, and Shawn Olason present. Chairman Carlblom called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m., roll-call was taken, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and the Agenda was reviewed.

Emergency Management – Emergency Declaration

Jessica Jenrich, Emergency Manager, presented an Emergency Declaration of Winter Storm Disaster for the recent ice storm. Cindy Schwehr moved to approve the declaration; Vicky Lovell seconded the motion. Motion carried upon roll-call vote, with all members voting "yes".

Barnes County, North Dakota Emergency Declaration

WHEREAS, The County of Barnes has suffered damages from Severe Winter Weather that was caused by rain, sleet, and winds that occurred from December 25, 2023 through December 27, 2023; and WHEREAS, heavy layer of ice, stressed by strong winds caused extensive damage to utility infrastructure; and WHEREAS, efforts to repair and restore infrastructure is creating damage to roads and right-of-ways and has caused extensive damages to the rural electric co-operatives; and WHEREAS, this storm caused power outages throughout the county, downed power poles and transmission line; and WHEREAS, this heavy ice and winds caused major tree damages and damage to buildings and property; and WHEREAS, the impact of these damages raise concerns and threaten the health, well-being, and public safety of citizens in the county of Barnes due to the storm; and WHEREAS, the cost of ice/snow removal and tree removal and the cost of repair, replacement and cleanup of damaged property is in excess of available citizen and county resources. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Barnes County Commission declares a state of emergency to include damages from severe storm activity and to utilize the Barnes County Local Emergency Operations Plan to limit the hardships and impact of this emergency upon the citizens of Barnes County. Cindy Schwehr updated the City County Health District parking lot repair and stripping will be done in the spring. New north doors are installed, and the electronic access is not finished. There was a glass office wall removed. Their old generator needs a switch installed that is not there and will be removed and replaced with a new generator installed in the spring. A lawyer has been secured to handle legal issues. Hours may change. Influenza is spreading. Vicky Lovell attended the library board meeting, and their budget has been approved. Garrison Diversion recreation application deadline is March first. Bill Carlblom tried to listen in on the last meeting but there was no sound. The Highway Department has received their new grader, and they have a new employee starting and another driver completed their CDL. Paul Lacina spoke regarding School District Building Fund Levy, and he is okay with the proposal of paying back four years of overpayment for 2019 – 2022 based on information he received from the Barnes County Auditor's Office.
