was happy to be able to recycle the 12 computers

which they were going to liquidate. They are all used equipment from the old First National Bank, he said.

"We would rather see the computers used locally," Finstad said. He also encourages other businesses to donate any used computers to the school.

"We are investing in the future, and we are glad we could help," he added.

In addition to the 12 computers, Norwest Bank also gave Patch kits as well as a Hub, which is used for networking, Finstad said.

"It was a win-win situation for all of us," Gentile said.

The Valley City Optimist Club also contributed \$2,000 to upgrade the network cable and software.

Gentile said each computer is equipped with word processing and Internet capabilities.

He said members of the community have also been taking advantage of the second computer lab, as well as students, who have even working on the computers before their early morning classes.

VCHS Principal Bob Toso said, "We now open the school at 7:30 a.m. so students can use this second computer lab. They also have a supervisor on hand at this time," he said.

The lab, which is open during the day, is often used for student to work individually and for individual classes.

Some school organizations have also taken advantage of the 24 computers, as well as the SAGA (spanning Age Groups with Artifacts) grogram.

The NDSU Extension Office has also used the computers for internet classes, according to Gentile.

Gentile said he is anticipating another six used used computers from the government in the near future.
