The Week Ahead: A beautiful stretch of spring weather is in store, with a mixture of sun, showers, and warm temperatures. A system will pass through on Thursday. but only a few sprinkles are expected. It will usher in warmer air for Friday, with highs reaching the mid 70s. A cold front on Saturday will drop temperatures by about ten degrees, back into the 60s, which is where we will stay through the rest of the forecast period. Another stray sprinkle could fall over the weekend, but right now odds just favor partly to mostly cloudy skies. A larger system propagates into the Northern Plains late Monday. This will bring a better chance for widespread rain showers. There is little agreement between models about where or when rain

will fall, besides that it could start as early as Monday night and persist in an on and off fashion until sometime in the middle of the week. Temperatures will cool as the storm pulls in cooler air from Canada, with highs by Wednesday dropping into the lower 60s. Breezy winds will accompany the showers.

Thursday: Mostly cloudy. A stray shower early. Highs in the mid 70s.

Friday: Mostly sunny. Highs in the mid 70s.

Saturday: Partly cloudy. Highs in the low 60s

Sunday: Partly cloudy. Highs in the upper 60s.

Monday: Partly cloudy. Highs in the upper 60s.

Tuesday: Mostly cloudy. Chances of showers. Highs in the upper 60s.

Wednesday: Mostly cloudy. Chances of showers. Highs in the low 60s.

Long Term: The end of the month looks to trend on the cooler side of average. In addition, probabilities favor slightly wetter conditions then are average for the end of the month.
