Barb Frydenlund spoke with the board in regards to the Opiate Settlement. It was motioned on February 21st to move funds to Public Health. Funding will go towards Mental Health. State Opiate funding: \$28749.47 should have already been funded back to county.

Time, Location, You can get the app on the phone and can see all units, you even receive alerts. The app updates every 30 seconds. Mickelson stated that it has dash cams too. It would cost roughly \$19 a month per unit. Motion by Abrahamson to go with Verizon if compatible with vehicles (9 blades, 4 pickups, 2 Sanding Trucks.) 2nd by Schlenvot. Motion passed by all member of the board.
