Get Vehicles Off The Streets

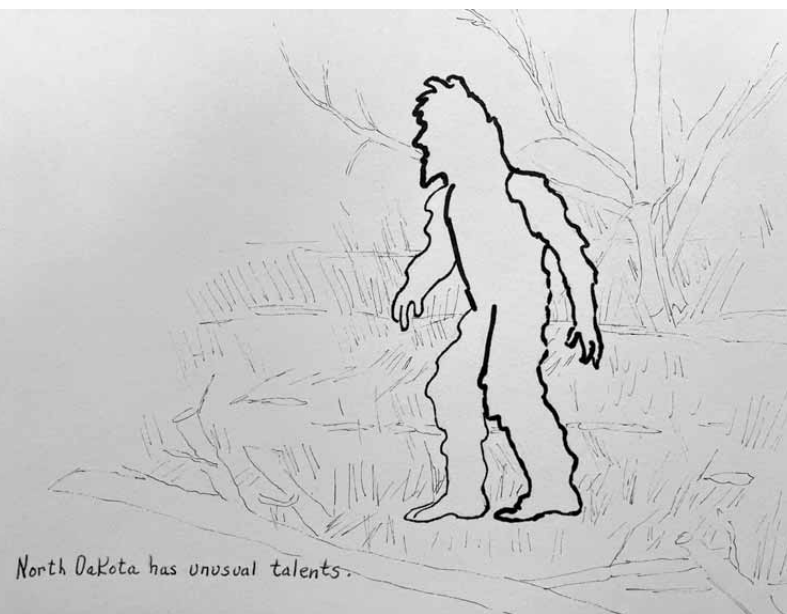
All trailers, car trailers, campers, and vehicles not in use, must be removed from city streets by January 15th to accommodate snow removal.
