

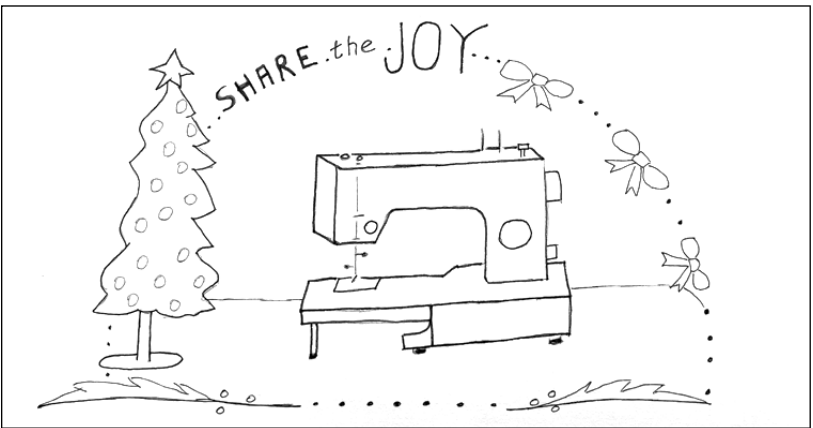

Grain Market

Berthold Farmers Elevator's Grain Merchandiser, Morgan Hall, reports: We are in the last month of 2025! What a ride the markets have had this year.

Spring wheat stayed in a \$0.10 range this week. Tuesday, Putin threatened to cut off Ukraine's access to the Black Sea, but the premiums faded as the day traded on.

Statistics Canada came out with their production numbers on Thursday. All wheat production hit a record high this year at 40.0

mil tons or 1.469 bil bu. Durum production is up 11.8% and spring wheat is up 10.3% compared to last year.

Canola production hit 21.8 mil tons. Acres were down from last year, but record yields throughout most of Canada pushed production higher. The market fell \$0.50/cwt Wednesday in anticipation of the report and another \$.26/cwt the day of the report. Canola needs China to come in and buy.

Canada reported flax production up to 17.8 mil bu. Barley production is up 19.4% from last year, again on solid yields.
