Making a map in 1915

Field work for the first geological survey of Dickey County wrapped up 110 years ago this month. Actual maps and reports based on the field work were scheduled for completion that coming winter.

The survey was done by contractors working for the United States Geological Survey. The project included all of Dickey County and the south half of LaMoure County.

No word on when the north half of LaMoure County got surveyed.

Crews inspected every quarter section in the county, noting the topography and altitudes of every township, section, railroad, river, creek, lake and house in the county.

The survey also noted geographical features like hills, valleys and wetlands in the county, It also provided a basic soil survey of the area.

"In addition to giving a good idea of

the soil value," wrote one newspaper. "It also locates, (and) determines the amount and value of the clays, cement, concrete rock and all mineral deposits, including gas and oil."

done, an atlas of the county could be published. "This work marks the expression


of another means whereby the government seeks to aid in economic development," wrote a Dickey County newspaper.

The survey cost the federal government about \$10,000 back in 1915. Adjusted for inflation, that would be about \$315,000 today.

Probably a pretty good deal. I'm sure all the atlases and maps of Dickey County published since then

have been based on that work.

Now, if they had just marked a little oil and gas resources in that survey we'd have something.



Copies Already for Distribution, Director of Work Announces

The sixth biennial report of the North Dakota state soil and geological survey is now ready for distribution. This long delayed agricultural report makes available for use the results of \$9,000 worth of work performed by five state and three cooperating federal men during 1911 and 1912



As often happens with extensive government surveys, the 6th Geological survey report was delayed considerably by unforeseen complications. In this case, World War I intervened, and it was not published until the end of the war came near. The headline and paragraph at left are from The Fargo Forum, September 17, 1918.
