Makoti City Meeting Minutes

The Makoti City Council met on Wednesday, April 2, 2025, 5:30 PM at the Makoti City Hall. Those in attendance were Mayor Karna, S.Huus, Howell, Giesen, C.Huus, Butterfield, Brooke Louks, Bridget Karna, and Sarah Stephens. Mayor Karna called the meeting to order, along with minutes, financials, and bills for the month. A motion was made by C.Huus, seconded by Giesen, to accept the consent agenda including minutes from the previous meeting, monthly financial reports, quarterly report, and bills to be paid. RCV/MC. Expenses for the month are all employee salaries, automatic utility payments, Circle Sanitation \$1,131.50, FDHU \$30.00, Ralph Butterfield \$39.45, SBPC \$150.00, Enerbase \$37.94, US Postal Service \$72.00, United States Treasury \$2,239.53, US Postal Service \$120.50, and Ralph Butterfield \$173.60. Old business was discussed. The 2024 Model Ordinances were discussed and will be tabled until next meeting. The Water Service Line Inventory was done with Moore Engineering on March 27. Overdue water bills were discussed. There is a grant program available to the city for city owned buildings. This may be used for the city building. Discussion was held.
New business was discussed. There is currently a legislative session for a possible Wastewater Infrastructure Grant that would cover up to 60% of the cost to finish rehabilitating the sewer lines in the city. C.Huus discussed the upcoming Threshing Show and Makoti Birthday celebrations. There was discussion about other special events that may take place on those days. Discussion was held. A motion was made by Howell, seconded by C.Huus to adjourn the meeting. -Stephanie Huus Auditor.
