# City council round up

The Douglas City Council was called to order by Mayor Jim Porter on Nov. 4.

Visitor to the meeting was Douglas Park Board member Tonya Karlson who proposed the purchase of four lots on block nine to use as a community garden on part of the property. The lots were used as RV's. The market value of the lots is \$17,000. The council approved the purchase of the lots contingent of being able to find funding from gaming grants and/or other state grant opportunities.
