Ρ & Board members The are responsible for making recommendations to the County Commission regarding development and land uses in the county. The appointment includes: Review of master plans/applications, zone change requests, zoning violations, and other items as instructed by the County Ordinance or County Commission. Ordinance or County Meetings are usually held the fourth Thursday of every month at 7:00 p.m. at the County Courthouse.

Weed Board members are

responsible for decisions on weed control in the county. Meetings are usually held 2-3 times per year, in the spring and in the fall.

The Park Board members are responsible for making recommendations to the County Commission regarding donation of park fund requests within the county. Meetings are held once a year during the June or July County Commission meeting.


