Oriental cultures to show respect to one another in this manner, however, bowing is encouraged in the Bible. Here's what the Psalmist said: "Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker" (Psalm 95:6 NIV)

In the prophecy of Micah, the question is asked: "With what shall I come before the Lord and bow down before the exalted God?" (Micah 6:6 NIV)
